The INTERCOM website is constantly being updated and reviewed, with all papers from the Vienna Conference 2007 now available to download. The papers from the New Zealand Conference of 2008 are currently being prepared for publication and will be available soon on the website. Images from the 2008 Conference have also been added to the site.

INTERCOM have had a very positive response to the Management Scenarios published this year. This resource is available to download via the website and in hard copy form from National Museums Liverpool. Many have been ordered to be placed in reference libraries as well as personal development use.

Intercom continues to align its work with the ICOM Strategic Plan (to which the President of Intercom made a major contribution). The main objective for Intercom is to draw together best management practice from around the world.

In pursuance of this objective we have organised a highly successful series of annual conferences. In 2008 our conference was held in Rotorua, New Zealand, on the subject of museums and tourism. Our website is very important in disseminating conference proceedings.

We also arranged management training for museums in Georgia and the surrounding region.

This 20 page document was funded with a grant from ICOM to celebrate their 60th anniversary and provides management with exercises to help develop their leadership skills.
